Overview:

Experience the most exciting wildlife safari sites in Africa, in the world's most famous national parks: Serengeti, Tarangire and Ngorongoro Crater, as well as the geological beauty of the East African rift valley.

Serengeti National Park is the oldest and most famous national park in Africa, and possibly the best-known wildlife sanctuary in the world. On the other side, Ngorongoro Conservation Area, a UNESCO's World Heritage Site, is the only places on Earth where mankind and wild animals coexist in harmony.

The tour will allow you to witness one of the World's natural Wonders and may be the only one left in the world - the 'Great Migration of the wildebeest and zebras' moving yearly within the Serengeti EcoSystem. The migrating animals are wandering from the woodland to the plains, and the interaction between species is awesomely entertaining.

Itinerary:

Day 1: Pick up from the Kilimanjaro Airport and transfer to Pink Flamingo hotel in Moshi - dinner & overnight accommodations are waiting for you (<u>https://pinkflamingotanzania.com/index.html</u>)

Day 2: Cultural Tour

After Cultural Tour Activities, we drive back to Pink Flamingo Lodge for overnight (https://pinkflamingotanzania.com/index.html)

Day 3: <u>Drive to Serval Wildlife</u> Overnight at Arumeru River Lodge (<u>https://www.arumerulodge.com/</u>) Drive for 1 hour 15 Min, from Moshi to Serval Wildlife for a two hour wildlife experience, with picnic lunch. After lunch, we drive for another 1 hour & 15 min to Arusha, staying at Arumeru River Lodge for evening relaxation with a soothing *MASSAGE (included in your package)*

This place is home to a variety of different animals such as the Majestic African Lions, Calm Colobus Monkeys, Graceful Masai Giraffes, Nocturnal Bat-eared Foxes, Exquisite Elands, Oafish Ostriches, and Mischievous Blue & Vervet monkeys! Offering unforgettable direct interactions with a variety of free-roaming wild animals.

Serval Wildlife is designed to provide a fascinating, exclusive, and unparalleled experience. This is a carefully curated ecosystem with over 3000 hand planted endemic flora that directly benefit the exquisite animals that reside within Serval Wildlife, from Serval you have the mesmerising views of Mount Meru and Mount Kilimanjaro.



Day 4: Tarangire National Park



After breakfast in the Arusha hotel, we drive 2-3 hours to Tarangire National Park for Game Drive with picnic lunch, overnight at Tarangire Safari Lodge. (https://www.tarangiresafarilodge.com/)

Tarangire is a beautiful national park, which supports the highest number of elephant families, more than any other national park in the Northern part of Tanzania. Together with a lot of other species of animals, this is also home to a variety of bird species found along the tropical region. With its expansive flora and fauna, this park will provide you an authentic safari atmosphere.

Day 5: Ngorongoro Conservation - Serengeti National Park:



After breakfast, we'll drive out of the Tarangire National Park to the Serengeti National Park via Ngorongoro Conservation Area Authorities with Optional Stop at Olduvai Gorge.

Overnight at Ang'ata Camp ... (<u>https://www.angatacamps.com/serengeti</u>) Ngorongoro Conservation Area Authorities (NCAA) is a large savannah with rain forest and bush land. The area provides wildlife protection status as well as allowing human habitation at the same time.

Day 6: Serengeti National Park



Enjoy a full day Game Drive in the Central Serengeti with picnic lunch; Serengeti is an expansive land, deriving it's name from the local tribes - it means 'Endless Plains' From the central toward the northern part of the park, there is a wide mix of vegetation which increases the animals diversitiy. **Overnight in Ang'ata Camps** – Dinner & Breakfast the next day included.(<u>https://www.angatacamps.com/serengeti</u>)

Depending on the tyme of year you visit, you may be able to witness the Great Migration

Day 07: <u>Serengeti National Park – Ngorongoro Conservation</u>



Early Morning Game drive in the Central Serengeti, then back to the Camp for breakfast. After breakfast, we proceed with the game drive on the way to the Ngorongoro Conservation Area, through Naabi Hill Gate with an optional visit at the Maasai Village to experience the life of the East African Nomads. We spend the night on the rim of the Crater in Ang`ata Ngorongoro Camp – full board. (<u>https://www.angatacamps.com/ngorongoro</u>)

Day 8: Ngorongoro Crater Day



In the Early Morning and after Breakfast, Descend into the Ngorongoro Crater for a Game Drive with picnic lunch. After lunch, ascend the crater and then drive to Kudu Lodge for overnight.... Full board......(<u>https://kuducamp.com/</u>)

Ngorongoro Crater is the largest unbroken caldera in the world, which is in the eastern part of Africa's Great Rift Valley; it was formed after an extinction of a huge volcanic mountain about 3 million years ago. On the other side the Crater is the park you may see the so called the 'Big Five' all together!

Day 9: Ngorongoro Highland Trekking / FAME Hospital & Rift Valley Children's Village

After Breakfast at the Lodge, we drive to the Ngorongoro Highland Forest which is about 20 Min drive from the Lodge.

Ngorongoro Highland Trekking is a two-hours walking safari through the forested slopes of the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. It is home to towering waterfalls and the incredible "elephant caves", created by elephants digging through dense rock with their tusks to ingest the vitamin-rich soil.

After the hike, we drive to FAME hospital for a visit and local lunch at Lilac restaurant. We will then visit Rift Valley Children's village before driving back to Arusha for Overnight. (this day's itinerary could easily be modified to suit your taste should you wish to do something different.)

Day 10: <u>Sure Wave Foundation Tanzania Program</u>. You will visit with the children at Christ Hope Orphanage (either morning or afternoon depending on the time of year and their school schedule), enjoy a morning coffee and /or lunch at a cafe downtown Arusha. Evening Transfer to Kilimanjaro International Airport for your international flight.

NOTE:

The price includes:

- Fueled 4WD pop-up safari vehicle,
- All transfers
- All park entry fees, tour charges and local taxes as per itinerary
- 9 nights full board hotel accommodation
- Fluently English-speaking wildlife safari guide/driver
- Bottled water during safari
- Soft Drinks during the drive
- All meals
- Air and ground ambulance cover for medical evacuation services

The price excludes:

- Driver/guide & resorts staff gratuity please plan on at least \$25-\$30/day, and be generous should you fall in love with your guide.
- Personal expenses, such as visa fee (\$100 for US & Canada residents), international flights insurance policy, etc. No vaccines are necessary unless you plan to extend your stay in Zanzibar or neighboring countries
